

WORCESTER YOUTH SOCCER LEAGUE
PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

All parents/guardians of any child that registers to play in Worcester Youth Soccer League must sign & accept this Code of Conduct before a child's registration will be accepted by the league. The Parent/Guardian who signs this form will also be responsible for any guests/friends/relatives or any other people that they invite to any game, event and/or practice associated with Worcester Youth Soccer League. By signing & accepting the Code of Conduct the person agrees to follow the polices/rules as outlined here or included in the League's or it affiliated organizations by-laws/polices & will abide by any sanction as imposed for violations without any other recourse or action.

I WILL:

- 1) Be encouraging, supportive & affirmative in regards to my child's play on the field & that of any child participating in a game or practice.
- 2) Respect all officials & accept their decisions quietly
- 3) Be supportive of the coach, asst. coach, manager, the team & the club
- 4) Offer to volunteer my services & talents to the team, & the league if possible & be supportive of those that do
- 5) Familiarize myself with the Laws of the Game
- 6) Comply with the rules, policies & procedures of the team, club & League as they apply to both my child & myself
- 7) Discuss my child;
 - a) Only with the coach and not any other person nor discuss another player, official, parent or league volunteer in any fashion except with the appropriate League Board Member
 - b) Only discuss issues concerning my child with their coach at a mutually agreed upon time & never prior to, during or directly after a game or match
- 8) If I have a specific concern or question will direct these to the proper individual within the league as follows:
 - a) An issue with a coach or asst coach to their respective age coordinator
 - b) An issue involving a referee w/the Director of Referees
 - c) An issue involving a question about registration to the league Registrar
 - d) An issue with an age coordinator to the Director of Rec.
 - e) An issue with field conditions/equipment etc to the Director of Operations
 - f) An issue with any other league officials to the League Vice-President
 - g) An issue involving another parent or adult to the President of the League

FUTHER, I WILL NEVER:

- 1) Engage in dissent directed towards a referee or official
- 2) Engage in any kind or type of unsportsman like conduct with any player, coach, parent, or official
- 3) Interfere at any time with the duties & responsibilities of a coach, asst. coach or team manager except if a child is placed in any kind of danger
- 4) Act in any manner which is detrimental to the team or Worcester Youth Soccer League, it's agents, sponsors or affiliated agencies/organizations
- 5) Never address the game Referee before, during, at half time or directly after a match except to point out potential safety hazards or an injured player that they may not have seen.

The League will deal with infractions of these rules on case-by-case bases. Depending upon the nature & factors involved penalties can include violators being banned from any facility/activity used or sponsored by WYSL up to a full year or longer.
